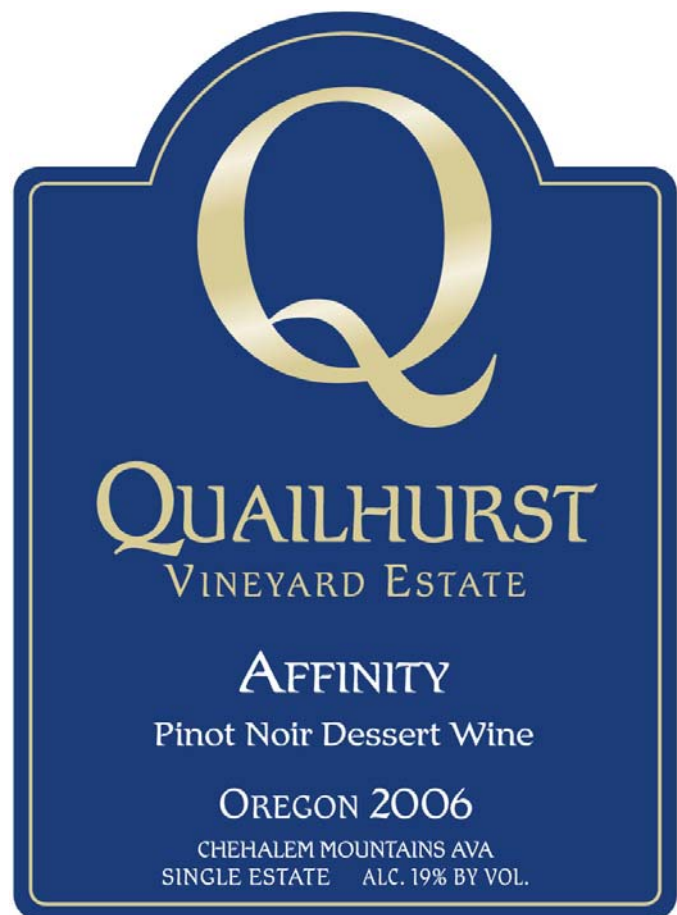

### The Vineyard

Situated in the middle of a southeastern slope on Ladd Hill in Sherwood Oregon, ranging in elevation from 575 to 675 feet. The soil is 100% ancient volcanic basalt called Jory.
